104 (S-1). Hearing for the Jewish Agency for Palestine

The General Assembly

Resolves:

1. That the First Committee grant a hearing to the Jewish Agency for Palestine on the question before the Committee;
2. To send to that same Committee for its decision those other communications of a similar character from the Palestinian population which have been received by the special session of the General Assembly or may later be submitted to it.

Adopted at the 75th meeting by 44 votes (Argentina, Australia, Belgium, Bolivia, Brazil, Byelorussian Soviet Socialist Republic, Canada, Chile, China, Colombia, Cuba, Czechoslovakia, Denmark, Dominican Republic, Ecuador, France, Syria, Ukrainian Soviet Socialist Republic, Union of Soviet Socialist Republics, United States of America) against 7 (Afghanistan), with 3 abstentions (Argentina, Syria, United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland) and one non-voting (Costa Rica)
