35/157. Israel nuclear armament

The General Assembly,

Recalling its relevant resolutions on the establishment of a nuclear-weapon-free zone in the region of the Middle East,

Reaffirming its resolution 33/71 A of 14 December 1978 on military and nuclear collaboration with Israel, and its resolution 34/89 of 11 December 1979 on Israel nuclear armament,

- 1. *Takes note of* the progress report of the Secretary-General on the work of the Group of Experts to Prepare a Study on Israel Nuclear Armament;
- 2. *Requests* the Secretary-General to pursue his efforts in this regard and to submit his report to the General Assembly at its thirty-sixth session;
- 3. *Decides* to include in the provision agenda of its thirty-sixth session the item entitled "Israeli nuclear armament".
